RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF BLAINE LAKE #434 BYLAW NO 04-2020

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH SPEED LIMITS OF SIXTY KILOMETERS PER HOUR ON MUNICIPAL ROADS IN THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF BLAINE LAKE #434

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Blaine Lake #434 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw shall be known as the "Speed Limit 60 Bylaw".
- 2. Speed:
 - No person shall operate a vehicle which is greater than 10,000 kilograms at a speed greater than sixty (60) km per hour on all municipal roads within the Rural Municipality of Blaine Lake #434.
- 3. Any person who contravenes any provisions of the bylaw is guilty of an offense and liable on summary conviction to the penalties imposed by *The Summary Offences Procedure Act, 1990* and any other applicable legislation.
- 4. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of clause 2 of this bylaw is guilty of an offense and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.
- 5. Any person who is in contravention of this bylaw may make a voluntary payment as per section 10(1) of *The Summary Offences Procedure Act, 1990* equivalent to the Provincial rates.
