BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Blaine Lake enter into a contribution agreement with the RM of Blaine Lake #434, and that the Town of Blaine Lake contribute additional funding to the jointly owned Blaine Lake Fire Department of \$30,000.00 over a 5-year period for payment of the RM of Blaine Lake #434 title share of property, 301 Main Street, Blaine Lake, SK (based on commercial value of property, of approximately \$160,000.00).

This in turn would keep the community working together and benefitting of all ratepayers.
