Beaver Control

The RM of Blaine Lake Participates in the Beaver Control Program. Please submit your contact information, a copy of your valid Trapper's license, and a completed Trapper Verification form to the RM office. Payment will no be released till all documentation is received in office. Contact the office for more information.

Farming RM Right-Of-Ways

The RM of Blaine Lake has adopted a policy on farming road allowances. An individual or corporation causing damage or altering a municipal right-of-way, by an agricultural operation, will be responsible for all costs of remediation deemed necessary by the municipality. Farming the shoulder of the road and the side slope to the base of the ditch, and the destruction of the grass thereon is strictly prohibited.

Dust Control Rebate

The Council of the RM of Blaine Lake No. 434 rescind the Dust Control Policy, and that any chloride application on municipal roads be solely at the ratepayer's expense.

Development and Building Inquiries

A development permit (approval) is required for all development and improvement within the RM. To ensure a timely process, please complete your application that has all the information required. Allow a minimum of 3-5 weeks for processing. Please do not start your project until you have the permit approval from Council. All permit applications are available at our office or online on our website. Please contact the office if you have any questions. Submit your request the Thursday prior to the Council meeting at the latest.

Gravel Requests

The Council of RM of Blaine Lake No. 434 may provide gravel to a ratepayer under the following certain circumstances:

- > If the RM is doing the gravel program, the loading and hauling can be done by our hauler and that the ratepayer will be invoiced for all costs when
- > If the RM is **NOT** doing the gravel program, the ratepayer is responsible for the loading and hauling costs. The ratepayer will need to make the necessary arrangements.
