SNOW REMOVAL: If you require any Snow Removal (Custom Work) on your property, please complete a 2019 Waiver at the office, along with supplying a \$60 deposit. The procedure then is to contact the office each time you need snow removal to be done, and provide your legal description that requires snow removal (ie. SE 36-44-07 W3rd). Fees are \$125/hour, custom rates apply in ½ hour increments, and RM rate payers are entitled to the first 20 minutes of snow removal at no charge (this applies only once per season).

<u>ADDRESSING CONCERNS</u>: If you have any RM-related comments or concerns, please put them in writing, addressed to the Reeve and Council, and send them into or drop them off at the RM Office, utilizing any of the contacts found at the top of this page.

BURNING IN THE RM: Make sure you call the Controlled Burn Line at 1-866-404-4911 **PRIOR** to burning, to avoid unwanted firefighting charges. Calling the Controlled Burn Line makes 911 dispatchers aware that there will be a fire and smoke in the area, should someone report the fire. The Controlled Burn Line can also be contacted to verify the RM's current Fire Ban status.

<u>FIRE INSURANCE</u>: This is a friendly reminder to all rural ratepayers to ensure that you have adequate fire insurance coverage on your property and home; don't make the mistake of assuming that this is automatically included in your policy, and make sure that your coverage is adequate to cover fire department costs.
