WASTE COLLECTION/DISPOSAL (Landfill Hours):

❖ WINTER HOURS (Oct 01 – Mar 31)

- Wednesday & Saturday, 10:00AM to 4:00PM
(Closed from 12:00 – 1:00 PM)

❖ SUMMER HOURS (April 01 – Sept 30)

- Tuesday, 3:00 – 8:00PM
- Wednesday & Saturday, 10:00AM to 4:00PM
(Closed from 12:00 – 1:00 PM)

RM #434 residents & ratepayers are allowed twelve (12) half-ton loads of garbage per year, free of charge; you need to provide your RM land location to the attendant on delivery to the landfill.

RESOURCES DEEMED ESSENTIAL BY THE MUNICIPALITY:

❖ Administration

- The office remains closed to the public and employees are working from home 90% of the time. Please communicate with the office via email or mail drop at the office, or call the office and leave a detailed voice message. We will reply to you as soon as possible.

❖ Public Works

- Workers are currently laid-off and are only called in when deemed necessary. Municipal main roads are considered essential – if you have any concerns regarding main roads, especially with spring thaw imminent, please report the specific location to the office for appropriate action; concerns could include snow removal, grading, emergency culvert repair, etc.
